The Budget Workshop of the Nisswa City Council was held on Wednesday, July 15, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall and was available on YouTube Live.

- B. 2021 Budget Discussion** – City Administrator Jenny Max presented information regarding the preliminary budget review for 2021. Max explained that about \$25,000 in the budgeted is equivalent to 1% on the levy. Discussion ensued regarding each city department’s preliminary budget projections, the potential for the city to take over the recycling center from Crow Wing County, pay for residents who participate in a committee or commission for the city, and projected cost of living increases and insurance increases.
