The Nisswa City Council Workshop was held on Tuesday, April 20, 2021 at 6:30 p.m. at City Hall and was available on YouTube Live.

- A. **Call to Order** – John Ryan called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

- B. **Ryan Schmidt, Schlenner Wenner & Co. – Presentation of the 2020 Audited Financial Statements for the City of Nisswa** – Ryan Schmidt joined the meeting remotely and presented the results of the audit through PowerPoint. Schmidt provided a summarized overview of the 2020 audit process for the City of Nisswa. The presentation included a review of the audit results, audit adjustments, internal control items, Minnesota legal compliance, financial/fund highlights to include revenues, expenditures and trend analysis, and outstanding long-term debt. For the 2020-year Schlenner Wenner & Co. expressed an unmodified (clean) opinion on the City’s financial statements. Max thanked Schmidt and his team at Schlenner Wenner & Co for their work during the audit process, and also thanked City staff for their ability to adjust to the audit process being done remotely this year.
